INITIATIVES

The employment unit engaged in the following broad outreach initiatives in accordance with various elements of FCC Rule 73.2080(c)(2):

Established an **internship** program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

KRCL's RadioACTive public affairs program offers a variety of internship opportunities.

- The Community Co-Host program teaches participants the skills necessary to host and produce a live radio talk show including proposing topics, booking guests, interviewing, & using equipment. They also co-host the nightly program one night each week, every other week, or monthly.
- During Spring semester 2023, RA
 collaborated with a team of students from
 Salt Lake Community College who
 booked, produced, and hosted the show
 each Thursday. It was offered as part of a
 class at SLCC.
- Production interns assisted with the show including managing gusts, editing audio, and tracking content on programs.
- Sound engineering interns learn the skills necessary to engineer live performances on the radio. We feature local bands live on air nearly every Friday all year long and sound interns fill in as available throughout the year, coordinated by our contract sound engineer.

KRCL facilitates a weekly hourlong program called Loud & Clear Youth Radio, led by our partners at SpyHop, airing on Saturday nights. Teens learn how to produce radio shows, DJ, and host interviews. KRCL provides space for instruction, studio time, and airtime.

Established **training** programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions.

KRCL's budget includes funds for staff participation in conferences and trainings specific to the broadcast industry.

- Membership Manager and General Manager attended the Public Media Development and Marketing Conference hosted by Greater Public in Chicago in July 2022.
- Assistant Program Manager, Director of Sponsorship, Director of Social Impact, and General Manager attended the Rocky Mountain Community Radio conference in Grand Junction in November 2022.
- Membership Manager attended the Corporation for Public Broadcasting training on Financial Reporting in January 2023.
- General Manager attended the CPB training on What is Non-Federal Financial Support in February 2023.

Provided training to management level personnel on methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and prevent discrimination.

- All KRCL staff including part-time and contract help participated in annual Harassment Training provided by the CPB.
- General Manager attended a webinar offered by the National Federation of Community Broadcasters to learn more about the Public Media for All campaign, which KRCL supports.

Participated in other activities designed by the station employment unit reasonably calculated to further the goal of disseminating information as to employment opportunities in broadcasting to job candidates who might otherwise be unaware of such opportunities.

- All full-time positions are posted to the Utah Workforce Services job bank, which makes job postings available to Workforce Service agencies throughout the state.
- KRCL offers Tongan language programming weekly and all KRCL job opportunities are announced on the show.
- KRCL sends out regular emails to approximately 12,000 subscribers informing them of station programming and events, community events, volunteer opportunities, and job opportunities.
- Information about employment is posted to KRCL's social media including Facebook and Instagram.
- KRCL's website indicates organizations may add their name to a list to be notified about all job postings. No one has notified us about their desire to be added yet.
